





WEIGHT INTENSIFIES THE EXPERIENCE



CONFESSION IS PATH TO PSYCHOLOGICAL FREEDOM

This is the path to freedom for it immediately clarifies his psychological position, removes him from a **highly** negative situation, frees him from pressure, and to a great extent, removes his guilt.

Five experiments involving 4,167 people from all over the United States.

Cheaters who confessed just part of their wrongdoing were also judged more harshly by others than cheaters who didn't confess at all

Partial confessions vs Full confessions - expressed higher regret

Partial confessions vs No confessions - increased feelings of guilt, shame and anxiety,

Full confessors vs Partial confessors- were more relieved and less guilt

"Paradoxically, people seeking redemption by partially admitting their big lies feel guiltier because they do not take complete responsibility for their behaviors. True guilt relief may require people to fully come clean." Eyal Pe'er
