




I learned about being a high-road leader today, its so common for organizations / leaders to displace a person once they are no longer of value to the company





- 2 sons representing 2 covenants
- Both represents 2 ways to live
- 1 way leads to slavery and the other way leads to freedom

- Hagar was a slave and Ishmael was therefore born into slavery
- Ishmael's birth was a natural one and therefore by nature we are all born into slavery to sin
- Sarah was Abraham's wife and Isaac was therefore born as a child of God's promise
- Isaac's birth was a supernatural one and therefore we are set free from slavery when we embrace God's promises
- It was naturally easy for Hagar to bear Ishmael as she was young and fertile
- It was biologically impossible for Sarah to bear Isaac as she was barren
- Everyone is either an Ishmael or an Isaac

"What is that something that is so important to me that I need and must have at all cost?"

- Sarah was stigmatized in her society because of her barrenness
- To avoid shame, she made Abraham conceive a child with her slave Hagar (normal in her culture)
- This was the fastest and most practical way to remove her shame as a barren woman
- When Ishmael was born her shame was temporarily removed as she claimed Ishmael as her own as according to the culture of that time
- However when Isaac was born, Ishmael was neglected as a son by Sarah and he began to mock Isaac. So Sarah asked Abraham to get rid of both Hagar and Ismael
- Despite Sarah's cruelty towards Hagar and Ishmael God rescued both of them from death in the desert

- I feel stigmatized in my society because I am not as well off as others
- To avoid shame, I engage in corrupted business practices to become rich (normal in our culture)
- This is the fastest and most practical way to remove my shame of not being prosperous and financially successful
- My shame is temporarily removed when others see my new car, new girlfriend and new home
- Due to my need to constantly earn respect of my peers, I need to continue to do more corrupted practices and my family life get's affected
- I have become a slave







Recognize the slavery in your heart that you need to get rid off

- Be aware that whatever you are pursuing for happiness might actually enslave you
- What occupies your thinking most of the time?
- What do you fear losing the most?

Jerusalem in Isaiah 54:1 is described as a barren woman

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<sup>27</sup> For it is written:
"Be glad, barren woman,
      you who never bore a child;
shout for joy and cry aloud,
      you who were never in labour;
because more are the children of the desolate
woman
      than of her who has a husband."
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Abraham. ⁸ Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." ⁹ So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

- He had more spiritual children than a typical married person

The difference between Christian friendship and secular friendship

- Friendship always starts with finding things in common with the other, then moving on to deeper connections – you are trying to form yourself in others
- Friendship is found in acceptance by others in a close social circle – you are trying to form yourself through others

How Christian friendship is formed

- Friendship starts with recognizing the common with the other in Christ, then moving on to deeper connections – you are both trying to form <u>Christ</u> in each other
- Friendship is found by others welcoming you into their social circle – you are all trying to form <u>Christ together</u> through unconditional acceptance

"I find it very hard to be friends with....."

Why would Jesus want to consider you His friend?

"I decided not to be friends with him because"

In the worldly kingdom people choose who they want to be friends with. In God's Kingdom Christ chooses people to be friends with each other

¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command. ¹⁵ I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. ¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. ¹⁷ This is my command: Love each other.

John 15:14-17

Who do you not want to eat with?

¹¹ When Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned. ¹² For before certain men came from James, he used to eat with the Gentiles. But when they arrived, he began to draw back and separate himself from the Gentiles because he was afraid of those who belonged to the circumcision group. ¹³ The other Jews joined him in his hypocrisy, so that by their hypocrisy even Barnabas was led astray.

Galatians 2:11-13

²⁶ So in Christ Jesus **you are all children of God** through faith, ²⁷ for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

- Christian friendship is often painful work.

Christian friendship is painful because it often involves receiving and giving rebuke

¹⁴ When I saw that they were not acting in line with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas in front of them all, "You are a Jew, yet you live like a Gentile and not like a Jew. How is it, then, that you force Gentiles to follow Jewish customs?

Galatians 2:14

You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. ²I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by believing what you heard? ³ Are you so foolish?

Galatians 3:1-3

No accountability

- Galatian Gentile Christians: "Peter.... We were stumbled when you decided not to eat with us anymore when this new group of Jewish teachers came to town"
- Peter: "Umm....I'm deeply sorry you felt offended"

Rebuking and receiving rebuke

- Before you rebuke someone ask yourself did you love him/her with the pain of childbirth
- Receiving rebuke from someone who loves you with the pain of childbirth is how God exposes areas of your life where you are in slavery


