YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY

Church family, our Young Adult Ministry is thriving, and we're excited to share how God is moving in our gospel-centered community as we pursue our vision of raising up godly disciple makers.

In a church hall that fits more than 500 people, it's easy for people to disengage. That's why we're passionate about creating spaces where connection, growth, and faith come alive. We have three core activities designed to foster connection at different levels.









FIRST - COFFEE CORNER

Our monthly gathering, welcomes young adults who aren't yet plugged into friend groups or deeper ministries. It's a warm, open platform where new faces can find community and belong.

NEXT - BI-MONTHLY SOCIALS

Our bi-monthly Socials—like pickleball and badminton—bring fun, casual vibes to build friendships among church members and even non-Christian friends who join us.

FINALLY - LIFE GROUPS

Life Groups are where the deepest connections happen. Through Bible study and prayer, these groups create space for young adults to grow in faith and support one another.







I have heard that people talk about the young adult ministry as being all fun and games. That's understandable, as we usually only make announcements for our coffee corner and socials. But in actuality, our most frequent activity is Life Group. In my visits to their gatherings, I see young people consistently display a hunger for God's word and a love for fellow believers. And this fruit is growing, as we have recently expanded our Life Groups from four to six groups.

In the past 12 months, we've seen other incredible milestones too.

In July 2024, we hosted our first-ever Young Adult Retreat, with 40 participants gathering for a three-day, two-night experience. We dove into meaningful topics: godly personal ambition, a godly vision for work, and the importance of rest. One session focused entirely on prayer and reflection, leaving us renewed and inspired. It was a powerful time of bonding and spiritual growth, setting a strong foundation for our ministry.

We've also organized inter-generational activities to bridge the gap between younger and older church members. The women had two events thus far - one a flower arrangement workshop and another, an evening hi-tea session. The men also met twice thus far for conversations over barbecue. These gatherings are starting points, designed to spark relationships that we pray will blossom into discipleship connections across generations. One young adult captured this beautifully, saying, "My discipleship is incomplete without the older generation." This heart for learning from the YA is a powerful reminder of the value of cross-generational mentorship, and we hope it encourages our entire church to lean into these relationships.

As we look ahead, we're filled with gratitude for how God is working. Young Adult Ministry is more than just events—it's a community where people find belonging, grow in faith, and step into their calling as disciple makers.

Whether it's a new face at Coffee Corner, a laugh-filled Social, or a heartfelt moment in Life Groups, we see God weaving stories of transformation. We're excited to keep building these connections and equipping young adults to live out their faith boldly. We invite you to celebrate these updates with us and continue supporting our young





adults. Your encouragement means the world as we grow together in Christ. Here's to more moments of connection, growth, and God's faithfulness in the days ahead!
