






#### **CONFESSIONS OF AN ATHEIST: WHY I LEFT**





his glory will not go down after him.




#### REFOCUS ON OUR MAIN AIM IN LIFE

It is not the next meal that matters but His will


Purpose of life is not comfort or food but His Will








#### JOHN'S TESTIMONY

"Faith is seen here as a he deliberate act, in defiance of one's emotional state and is saie.




