

YOUR STORY, HIS GLORY: ANSWER THE CALL TO BAPTISM

Mark your calendars! Our next Baptism Ceremony is on 13th December 2025 (Sat).

Have you accepted **Jesus** as your **Lord and Saviour**? If your heart says "yes," then baptism is your joyful and vital next step of

obedience. This isn't about having a perfect faith; it's about publicly declaring your trust in a perfect Saviour and stepping into the fullness of His promise.









WHY IS BAPTISM SO IMPORTANT? IT'S WHAT JESUS COMMANDED AND WHAT UNLOCKS A DEEPER WALK WITH HIM!

AN ACT OF OBEDIENCE AND A PUBLIC DECLARATION:

Water baptism is an act of faith and obedience to the commands of Christ. Baptism declares that you are a follower of Jesus Christ. It is a public confession of your faith in, and commitment to, Jesus Christ.

Before He ascended to heaven, Jesus gave us a clear instruction: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28:19). This command links baptism directly to the beautiful promise of God's presence and power in our lives.

In fact, the Apostle Peter directly connected baptism to receiving the greatest gift God has for us: "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38). Baptism is an act of faith where we publicly identify with Christ, and God faithfully responds by sealing us with His Spirit—our Helper, Guide, and guarantee of eternal life.

WHAT IS THE MEANING AND SIGNIFICANCE OF BAPTISM?

Baptism is also a beautiful picture of the gospel – a symbol of Christ's burial and resurrection. It symbolizes the wonderful truth that

"all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death... we were therefore buried with him... in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead... we too may live a new life." (Romans 6:3-4).

As you rise from the water, you are powerfully declaring, "My old life is buried, and I am raised to new life in Christ—a life empowered by the Spirit!" It is how we publicly "clothe ourselves with Christ" (Galatians 3:27).

A GLIMPSE OF THE JOY: OUR PAST BAPTISM

HEAR FROM YOUR CHURCH FAMILY

Don't just take our word for it. Here's what some of your brothers and sisters who were baptised in June experienced:

"I kept waiting to feel 'ready,' but God showed me that baptism is an act of faith. Taking that step was like the Ethiopian eunuch saying, 'Look, here is water. What can stand in the way?' (Acts 8:36). It was the most freeing moment, and I truly felt a new infilling of the Holy Spirit afterwards."



"I was nervous, but the moment I came out of the water, I felt a wave of peace—a tangible reminder that I am clean, forgiven, and have received the gift of the Holy Spirit. It was a day I will always cherish."

IS GOD CALLING YOU TO TAKE THIS STEP?

If you have believed in your heart, we invite you to confess with your life through baptism. Don't let hesitation hold you back from this step of obedience and blessing.

A BRAND-NEW LIFE

It is a symbol of your new life as a Christian. We bury the "old life", and we rise to walk in a "new life". Baptism is like a wedding ring; it is the outward symbol of the commitment you made in your heart, a commitment that must be followed through and lived out on a daily basis. It's meant to show the world that you love, trust, and have put your hope in Christ.

WHO SHOULD BE BAPTISED?

Every person who has made the decision to believe in Christ. When Paul writes to the believers in Rome, he assumes that all of them have been baptised (Romans 6). The one requirement for baptism is belief in Christ!



"Those who accepted his message were baptised." **Acts 2:41**

"But when they believed Philip as he preached the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptised, both men and women." **Acts 8:12**

We believe in baptising children when they are old enough to understand what it means and make a personal declaration of belief.

When are we to be baptised?

Believers in the New Testament were baptised on the same day. As soon as a person decides to believe in Christ, he can be and is encouraged to be baptised. "Those who accepted his message were baptised." (Acts 2:41)

"Then Philip began with that very passage of scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. As they travelled along the road, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptised?" And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptised him." (Acts 8:35-39).

At FBC English, a baptism ceremony is organised every 6 months.
