

Christine: I have two daughters. Both of them are Christians. When one of my daughters was diagnosed with a sickness, we didn't know who to seek after for help. So, my younger daughter led me to pray. In my prayer, I challenged God. I said: "God, if my daughter is healed, I will follow you." And here I am today! My daughter is healed. She is in remission now. And I have kept my promise to God. I now follow Jesus and am learning about Christianity. Alpha class came just at the right time; I announced my conversion on Christmas day and I was told about the Alpha class in early January! Every Wednesday, I would look forward to attending Alpha. It came at the right time. I believe God has His plans, and He is leading me step-by-step.
