

candidates to choose from the heavens above.
Astrobiologists believed that it was only a matter of time before evolved lifeforms would be found. But not so fast, my friend.

The Bible tells the story of life being created by God and not because of some atheistic evolutionary force. Intelligent design was involved. This is evident in our own solar system where, with 8 officially classified planets, only the Earth has life. The rest are dead worlds.

But just because Mars is a dead world today, does it mean that it was dead all along? So, probes were sent to look for evidence of life. First, there were the fly-past space probes, followed by orbiters, and then landers. They found nothing. Later, rovers also found nothing.

There's one big difference between the landscapes of Earth and Mars: even in the most hostile environments on Earth, there's life; not so on Mars. Mars is bone dry with an atmosphere only about 1% the density of Earth's. With the hope of finding ancient life forms a fleeting reality, the search switched to finding water. They did find some trace evidence of water, but no life.

Earth on the other hand has seas and oceans covering some 70% of its surface. Additionally, there's 2% fresh water found in rivers and lakes. Without these water coverings, our planet would be overheated as the seas and oceans are needed to regulate and buffer the temperature. And the waters of the Earth are prevented from evaporating into space by the presence of a thick atmosphere. On Earth, there is life, forests, trees, shrubs, grasslands, and plankton-covered oceans. The balance in the ecology is simply too amazing to be discounted as coincidence.

In the Biblical narrative, the creation of the Earth is a carefully thought out one. First, there was the creation of light, by which all standards were measured, giving rise to distance and time, which in turn gave rise to the concept of speed.

After day and night were realized and the moon created to regulate and synchronize a calendar, life was created- plants first, and then living creatures. Finally, human beings were created and placed in the beautiful garden of Eden.

All things were put in place in good order for life to not only be sustained but to flourish. Different parts of creation supported each other in good order for things to work well. Everything was good.

That being such, the search for life, past or present, on Mars, or anywhere else in the universe would prove futile, unless God had already created life there. Life had to be created or else there wouldn't be life at all.

Describe Saujana LG in 3 words.

What is the story behind Saujana LG?

Saujana LG was initiated after some of us had completed the Alpha course and were looking to meet regularly in the Saujana area. It was formed in 2016 by Yew Lum and Cynthia. The venue was changed to Glenmarie @Aldrin's office after Yew Lum and family moved to Bangsar in 2018. God has since blessed our LG family in that it grew significantly, from 6 to 8 members to over 20 regulars within the first 2 to 3 years. This subsequently led to the formation of another LG called 'CIA' (Christians In Action) in Subang Jaya comprising mainly of families with young children. In 2021, the addition of new members led to another spin-off LG called 'New Life' comprising of a mix of former Saujana members and newcomers to FBC.

Tell us more about Saujana LG today.

There are currently about 13 to 14 regular attendees. The profile of Saujana has certainly changed over time since we encourage new groups to be formed out of the old one in order to keep LGs small and more intimate. Today, our LG is mainly made up of professionals, a few young adults, a couple of students, and four very supportive home-makers!

As we come from different walks of life, different backgrounds, and have different personalities, it took us some time to gel and bond. In the past year, we had a few soul-searching moments where we intentionally encouraged each other to open up and share our struggles and victories in our Christian walk.









The LG must be a safe space for us to talk without fear of being judged. We also seek to have our lives transformed by God's word and not just do Bible study to accumulate head knowledge. In all these areas, we are still very much a work-in-progress, trusting in God's power to mature every one of us.

What does Saujana LG do when you meet?

We meet fortnightly on Friday from 8:30pm to 10:30pm. Prior to MCO, the hours would often extend to past 11pm, especially with great fellowship and delicious supper.

During our LG session, we worship, decipher Bible verses, discuss biblical truths/ principles, and learn its application in our lives, pray, and share our inner thoughts with one another. Sometimes, for each LG member to have an opportunity to voice their opinion, we would break the group into even smaller groups to discuss, share, and pray.

Sometimes, we would even have a quiz to give our brain some teasers! Of course, all this is topped off with fellowship over supper each time we met. Since the pandemic, most of our LG meetings have been conducted via ZOOM. However, when the situation permits, we would meet up for fellowship and activities like hiking and having meals together.

Carolyn: "The intrinsic value imparted to me by our LG has immensely transformed and molded my inner self-development, helped me overcome my weaknesses, and enabled me to be more conformed to the image of God."

Janet: "It has been almost 5 years since I re-joined Saujana LG. I experienced the love and care from all of them when I was down with some personal issues. They have been like my extended family as my own family was not in favour of me leaving the Catholic faith. What I thought I lost when I left Roman Catholicism, I am blessed to have found in our LG instead. May God bless everyone."

What is enjoyable about being part of a Life Group?

Carolyn: "The fun part of having a Life Group is the feeling of affection we have for one another, the care and support we offer to our LG "family". Being part of Saujana LG has edified me with the true essence of comfort and assurance. All of us in Saujana LG display a sense of exuberance whenever we meet and get together. We practice the joy of giving and gratitude."

Saujana LG's forté is organising fun activities in hopes to foster bonding and fellowship within our LG. Our activities include games and gatherings ranging from bowling, Jenga, hiking, mountain climbing, midnight bah kut teh, makan-makan, double-dates, birthday celebrations, BBQ and Pot Bless, Christmas and Chinese New Year gatherings. Our LG's tradition is to gather for a CNY luncheon every year. This has been our opportunity to connect with another LG or invite some families whom we felt we wanted to get to know more of.


