

Micky Lee's testimony:

From the beginning, each of us had to take turns leading a weekly Bible study. This reinforced our efforts to explore the background of the text deeper. It helped to understand the sermons further when we were doing the same books. It often made us ponder on the impact of the message on us. Life group supported me through sharing Bible knowledge and life experiences. We are using the typical flow of conducting a cell group, therefore we are getting used to it. Unexpectedly, we found that we knew too little of God's Word even though we have read the Bible a couple of times.

Christine Chiew's testimony:

We all used to join the Sunway cell group from a previous fellowship where we physically met every Friday night at Brother Jacob's house. As our beloved Brother Jacob has gone to his rest with the Heavenly Father, with the spread of Covid, we started our online meeting via Zoom every Saturday night. Hence, the Rhema group was started.

After joining the Rhema group, each of us had to take turns leading the Bible studies. I had to study from a lot of reference materials to equip myself. With God's guidance and help from group mates, I have a better understanding of the Bible. Rhema provided me with prayers, bible knowledge, and their life experiences (as most of them are much older than me). My Bible knowledge is indeed more profound after joining the cell group, and I have a much deeper understanding instead of just scratching the surface of the Bible.

It seems like the group is really enjoying digging deeper into God's word! I hope they continue to grow together in the Lord and encourage one another so that they become wise for salvation as it says in 2 Timothy 3:14-15, "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

Devotions on Isaiah 66:1-2: God Big, Me Small.

Scripture: Isaiah 66:1-2

This is what the Lord says:

"Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be? Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?" declares the Lord. "These are the ones I look on with favor: those who are humble and contrite in spirit, and who tremble at my word."

Observation

These verses show how great and magnificent God is. To refer to the earth as His "footstool" just further emphasizes how big and powerful He is, and how small we are - literally and figuratively. We are weak and powerless in comparison to God.

It brings me to this question - why do I always view that I am above God?

Application
